

2021-2022 Full Armor Christian Academy Dress Code



The school dress code applies to all Full Armor students on campus and at school-related events. As a Christian, we must concern ourselves with our appearance. By our dress we represent the feelings and thoughts of our hearts. This being the case, our clothing and the way we wear it should represent our desire to please and honor God.

Key items to the Full Armor dress code are: neatness, modesty, and not drawing attention to one's self. On occasion there very well could be situations where something not listed may have to be brought to the attention of the student. It is the parent's responsibility to be familiar with the dress code and to ensure that their children are in compliance each day.

All items should be maintained in clean and presentable condition without tears, excessive stains or obvious disrepair. Additional dress days are designated by faculty and/or administration. It is important to note that if any questions arise, on any issue, the decision of the administration prevails.

Girls' Daily Attire:

- Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform pants, skirts, skorts, jumper, or shorts.
- High school students have the option of wearing blue jeans with the exception of chapel day.
- Polo style shirt (long or short sleeves) – solid colors – Full Armor logos or 1" X 1" store logos are acceptable. High school students have the option of wearing a Full Armor spirit shirt untucked with the exception of chapel day.
- Brown, black, khaki, or navy belt (Pre-K and Kindergarten students are not required to wear belts.)
- Closed-toe shoe, dress flat, dress/cowboy boot, athletic shoes, or Keds-style shoes

Girls' Athletics Attire (6th-12th Grade):

- Athletic shorts – Biker shorts must be worn when athletic shorts are not finger length.
- Full Armor approved logo shirts, Christian t-shirts and solid color shirts/sweatshirts are acceptable
- Full Armor approved logo or solid color sweatpants (Yoga or spandex type pants or shorts are prohibited.)
- Athletic socks and non-marking tennis shoes

Girls' Chapel Attire:

- Khaki uniform pants, skirts, skorts, jumper, or shorts
- Hunter green polo shirt (tucked in)
- Brown, black, or navy belt
- Closed-toe shoe, dress flat, dress/cowboy boot, athletic shoes, or Keds-style shoes
- Full Armor approved sweater, or hunter green cardigans may be worn
- Letter jackets and hunter green Full Armor hoodies may be worn

Girls' Spirit Dress:

- Blue jeans, uniform pants, or uniform shorts (No blue jean shorts are allowed.)
- Full Armor and *East Texas Baptist University approved t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt

Girls' Picture Day Dress:

- Fall Pictures
 - Dress for Fall Picture Day will follow the chapel dress guidelines—No Exceptions
- Spring Pictures

- Dress for Spring Picture Day will adhere to respectful “church” attire (Pants, shirts, dresses are acceptable. All items should be maintained in clean and presentable condition without tears, excessive stains or obvious disrepair. Any questions, please contact administration.)

Boys’ Daily Attire:

- Khaki or navy uniform pants or shorts.
- High school students have the option of wearing blue jeans with the exception of chapel day.
- Polo style shirt (long or short sleeves) – solid colors – Full Armor logos or 1” X 1” store logos are acceptable. High school students have the option of wearing a Full Armor spirit shirt untucked with the exception of chapel day.
- Brown, black, khaki, or navy belt (Pre-K and Kindergarten students are not required to wear belts.)
- Closed-toe shoes, dress shoes, cowboy boots, or athletic shoes

Boys’ Athletics Attire (6th-12th Grade):

- Basketball style shorts
- Full Armor approved logo shirts, Christian t-shirts and solid color shirts/sweatshirts are acceptable.
- Full Armor approved logo or solid color sweatpants are acceptable.
- Athletic socks and non-marking tennis shoes

Boys’ Chapel Attire:

- Khaki uniform pants or shorts
- Hunter green polo shirt (tucked in)
- Brown, black, or navy belt
- Closed-toe shoes, dress shoes, cowboy boots, or athletic shoes
- Full Armor approved sweater, hunter green sweater may be worn.
- Letter jackets and hunter green Full Armor hoodies may be worn.

Boys’ Spirit Dress:

- Blue jeans, uniform pants, or uniform shorts (No blue jean shorts are allowed.)
- Full Armor and *East Texas Baptist University approved t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt

Boys’ Picture Day Dress:

- Fall Pictures
 - Dress for Fall Picture Day will follow the chapel dress guidelines—No Exceptions
- Spring Pictures
 - Dress for Spring Picture Day will adhere to respectful “church” attire (Slacks, button up shirts are acceptable. All items should be maintained in clean and presentable condition without tears, excessive stains or obvious disrepair. Any questions, please contact administration.)

General Guidelines for All:

OUTERWEAR

- All Full Armor and *East Texas Baptist University approved logo jackets, letter jackets, sweatshirts, pullovers, and hoodies are allowed to be worn on campus, in the classroom, and all school-related events. Non-Full Armor outerwear may only be worn provided the outerwear is a solid color with no store logo. Non-Full Armor outerwear that is not a solid color may be worn to and from outdoor classes. (Chapel has its own dress code rules.)

SHIRTS

- Polo shirts must always be tucked in except for Thursday casual dress.
- Shirts and tanks worn under polo shirts must be solid navy, white, grey, or black with no visible writing.

BOTTOMS

- Pants and shorts must be worn above or at the hips.
- NOT ALLOWED: inappropriately tight jeans or pants (skinny jeans), bellbottom-style pants; jeggings or leggings worn as pants; athletic shorts, warm-ups or jeans with rips, holes, frays, or tears
- Shorts, skorts, and skirts must be no more than 3” from the crease of the back of the knee or from the top of the knee in front.
- Modesty shorts or tights must be worn when wearing skirts or jumpers

FOOTWEAR

- No sandals, flip-flops, crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels or lights, house shoes/slippers, or skeletoes may be worn at any time.
- Knee-high socks are permissible when wearing skirts or dresses.
- Socks must be solid color and no taller than a crew sock (mid-calf)

HEADGEAR

- Hats, beanies, or other headgear, including hoodies, may not be worn during school hours.
- Hair will be neat and properly groomed. Unusual or extreme hairstyles including, but not limited to, multiple level shaving and unnatural hair color are not acceptable.
- Boy’s hair should not be longer than the top of the collar and the middle of the ear, and should not cover the eyes.
- Boys must be clean shaven.
- Girl’s hair should not cover the eyes at school, i.e. should be pulled back with clips, bows, etc.
- Bows and headbands (if worn) will be solid colors unless otherwise stated by administration for class parties.

ACCESSORIES

- Piercings (one earring per lobe) are permitted for girls in grades (K4-5th)
- Makeup and piercings (two earrings per lobe) are permitted for girls in grades 6th-12th
- Modest, non-distracting jewelry may be worn to school.
- Tattoos either permanent or temporary must be covered during school and while attending all school-sponsored events (i.e. field trips and sporting games).
